

Future Hospital Programme: Delivering the future hospital

The Royal College of Physicians (RCP) Future Hospital Programme launched its [final report](#) which looks at the impact of the programme. The Future Hospital Commission was a report that was radical, engaging and popular, full of new ideas and solutions to the common problems that beset the NHS. It was funded by the RCP to implement the recommendations of the commission. The learning from the FHP pilot sites have led to the development of best practice with new models of care tailored for delivery elsewhere.

The Programme has seen the launch of the RCP flagship [Chief Registrar](#) leadership programme, developing the next generation of clinical leaders. The scheme offers senior leadership roles which focus on developing high quality patient care and providing junior doctors with a voice.

Although the formal Future Hospital Programme is drawing to a close, the learning will be incorporated into the RCP's new [Quality Improvement Programme](#), which will provide support to clinicians and their teams to deliver improvements in care and services.
