



Expression of Interest – NASG Vice Chairs & Devolved Nation Leads

Formed in 2001, the aim of the National Allergy Strategy Group (NASG) is to improve the lives of all people with allergies in the UK and influence Government to improve allergy services across the National Health Service so that all allergy patients receive high-quality care with equitable access, regardless of where they live in the UK. Over time, this remit has expanded and now relates to wider aspects impacting the quality of life of people with allergies and their families.

The NASG is an alliance of the professional organisation BSACI (British Society of Allergy and Clinical Immunology), the patient charities, Allergy UK, Anaphylaxis UK, and Natasha Allergy Research Foundation. The current chair is Professor Adam Fox. In mid-2024 the NASG embarked on its most ambitious project yet – a National Allergy Strategy and this means more capacity is needed to support our work.

We are therefore opening up two new roles to support the current Chair. The Vice Chair roles will provide advice and support for the Chair and would ideally have a long track record of working strategically, either within a healthcare setting or other relevant area. You would need to be a team player who is passionate about improving the lives of allergy sufferers. A history of positive working with our core members would be highly desirable.

In addition, the NASG is looking for leads from each of the devolved nations. These roles would suit a candidate with a good working understanding of the healthcare and government ecosystem in the devolved nation and ideally already has held relevant leadership roles.
