

## **BSACI GPwER in Allergy Assessors**

### **Who can be an Assessor**

- Must be a BSACI member
- Accredited GPwER,
- Consultant Allergist (Paediatric or Adult)
- Paediatrician with a Special Interest in Allergy
- Consultant Immunologist with a Special Interest in Allergy

### **What is the role of the Assessor**

- Each GPwER candidate will have two assessors
- The assessor would need to review the candidate's paperwork to sign off the applicant
- Assessors will be given 4-6 weeks to complete the assessment. The assessors' forms may be found [here](#)
- Both assessors must approve the candidate before the national lead can provide final sign-off and grant GPwER accreditation
- Assessors shall confer with one another and/or the GPwER National Lead to reconcile any discrepancies in assessments or to address queries and concerns
