### Food Immunotherapy Clinical Practice Statement Writing Group

Food Immunotherapy offers the chance for patients to experience less unexpected reactions and reduce their risk of anaphylaxis, whilst requiring that the patient (and family) adhere to specific safety recommendations. The BSACI has been asked to collate a Clinical Practice Statement that outlines safe parameters for the delivery of Food Immunotherapy from a service point of view, whilst there is increasing interest in common foods being used to offering such treatment pathways.

We are looking for healthcare professionals from different specialities to contribute towards this CPS:

- **Adult allergist**
- **Nurse specialist**
- **Dietitian**
- **GP**
- **Paediatric allergist**

We will collate evidence from the literature and review published recommendations for practice from groups with established experience. Our aim is to come to a consensus on its safe practice for the UK.
