- Actively participating in BSACI Adult Allergy Group (AAG) meetings three times a year
- Coordinating the Medical Scholarship Award scheme at the BSACI Annual Conference
- Taking an active role in developing new BSACI initiatives that benefit trainees and junior members, helping to take the role forward in a proactive and innovative way.
